Research Scientist-I (Medical):

Essential Qualification: MBBS Degree recognized by MCI from a recognized University

Desirable Qualification:

- (i) MD/MS Degree in Medicine/Surgery/P&SM, Pathology/Radiotherapy/Biochemistry/Pharmacology from a recognized University.
- (ii) Additional Post doctoral research/teaching experience in the relevant subjects in recognized institute(s).
- (iii) Knowledge of Computer Applications.

Job Requirements: To develop programmes for research and training, plan & undertake research on different aspects of Cancer to assist the Principal Investigator and, to work with other scientists in conducting research in thrust areas.

Statistician:

Essential Qualifications: Three Years Graduates Degree in Mathematics with Statistics as one of the major subjects/Economics/Operational Research/Agriculture Statistics or equivalent with two years research experience in the above mentioned subjects or Two Years Diploma in Computer Applications.

Desirable Qualifications: Knowledge of statistics related computer software like SPSS, EPINFO, EPI-STAT & application packages like MS-Office.

Job Requirements: To work under the guidance of senior statisticians in data analysis using modern medical statistical tools, and to strengthen ongoing research programmes in the area of expanding cancer research activities both in intramural and extramural works etc.

Social Worker:

Essential Qualification: Three years graduate degree in social work/medical sociology/anthropology/psychology from a recognized University with five years experience in the relevant community-bases studies in health & social sciences.

OR Master's Degree in social work/medical sociology/anthropology/psychology (MA/MSW) or graduate with 2 years diploma in social work.

Desirable Qualification: Knowledge of use of computer software for qualitative & quantitative data analysis. Data Collection, documentation, data entry, data cleaning, analysis, data transcription.

Data Entry Operator:

Essential qualifications: Three year graduate degree from a recognized university (with good command over spoken and written grammatical English) with knowledge of data entry work.

Desirable qualifications: (i) Speed of 8000 key depressions per hour & at least 3 years experience in operation of PC. (ii) Knowledge of DTP packages and use of software programmes will be an added qualification. (iii) Qualification in Stenography/Maintenance of accounts, cashbook ledgers will be a major advantage.

Terms and Conditions:
